- You want to learn more about your personality, interests, skills, and values and how these relate to your career choices.
- You feel pressured to choose a major.

The UNDECLARED PROGRAM is NOT for you if...

- You know what major you want to pursue but MCC does not offer it as a degree. Instead, choose Liberal Arts and seek advisement.
- You have over 30 college credits.
- You are attending MCC to take pre-requisites for another college. Instead, choose Liberal Arts and seek advisement
- You were denied acceptance into your first choice program but still want to pursue it.
- You are accepted into a 2+2 program. Consult the Career Center before opting out of your articulation agreement.
