**Monroe Community College** is well known for its strong tradition of outstanding catchers. MCC backstops have earned numerous All-Region, All-District, and All-American honors throughout the years. These awards have been based not only on offensive production, but on defensive excellence as well.

Many Tribune catchers have been honored for their outstanding play. 2008 alum Cory Brownsten was a first team All-American and was the EastonT Defensive Player of the Year. He was drafted in the 15th round of the 2010 Major League Baseball Draft by the Atlanta Braves and currently plays in their farm system. Brownsten and current MCC catcher AJ Kehlenbeck have also been recipients of NJCAA Rawlings Gold Gloves for their superior defensive skills.

The camp has a wide-ranging array of drills to develop young catchers. The techniques, drills, and philosophies preached to MCC catchers are in turn taught to the campers to further develop their skills. Numerous boys and girls who have attended have gone on to excel at the position.

The camp allows the time needed to focus on a position that is so important to the game of baseball. Techniques of the position are taught and refined with a multitude of drills focused on throwing mechanics, blocking, receiving, pitch-calling, bunt coverage, covering home plate, and becoming a team leader. There will also be film study sessions on major league and college catchers. Every camper will receive a camp T-shirt and have the opportunity to win awards.



## Camp Staff and Bios:

### **Mike Kelly – MCC Head Baseball Coach**

Coach Kelly is entering his fifth year as MCC head coach and has worked the Catcher's camp for 12 years. He was the 2008 and 2009 Region III and East District Coach of the Year after leading the Tribunes to back-to-back JUCO World Series appearances. The 2008 squad finished third in the nation and recorded a team-record 41 victories. He was an All-Region catcher at MCC and later went on to play at SUNY Brockport.

### **David Brust – MCC Assistant Baseball Coach**

Coach Brust is also working the Catcher's Camp for the 13th year. An All-American at MCC in 1987, he went on to play at Ball State where he was a captain and two-time team MVP. Brust played professionally in the Atlanta Braves organization from 1989 to 1992. Two of those seasons were spent playing for the Durham Bulls under former Boston Red Sox and Los Angeles Dodger manager Grady Little. He also is the head coach and general manager for the Webster Yankees of the New York Collegiate Baseball League.

### **Tony Fuller – MCC Assistant Baseball Coach**

Coach Fuller is in his second year as a coach in the MCC baseball program. As a player, Fuller helped lead the Tribunes to regional titles in 2005 and 2006. He was an All-Region selection his sophomore season as MCC set a then-school record with 40 wins. He continued on and played two years at the University of Buffalo, where he was also a volunteer assistant coach. He has also been the head coach of the Braman Post American Legion team.

### **Ryan Sullivan – MCC Assistant Baseball Coach**

Coach Sullivan was an All-Region catcher at Monroe Community College and also played at the University of Rochester. This is his seventh year on the Catcher's Camp staff.

**Cory Brownsten** - This is Cory's second year working at the catcher's camp. 2008 Gold Glove Recipient during his sophomore year at Monroe Community College before transferring to the University of Pittsburgh. He is currently a catcher for the Atlanta Braves organization.
