COMMERCIAL VEHICLE ENFORCEMENT (CVE) WEIGHT AND PERMIT COURSE

May 31 – June 1, 2012

8:30 AM to 4:30 PM

The Public Safety Training Center in partnership with the Greece Police Department, will conduct the two- day **Commercial Vehicle Weight and Permit Course**. This course will be held in room 109, at the Public Safety Training Facility, 1190 Scottsville Road, Rochester, NY.

This course is offered to those officers/departments seeking additional training in commercial vehicle enforcement. It looks in depth at weights, dimensions, special hauling permits, non divisible load permits and certified escort vehicles. These subjects are covered in the first day of the course in the classroom and then used practically in a day of field exercises on the second day of the course. The field exercise will include use of scales to weigh vehicles (provided by Greece PD).

Ideally, those who attend should have or plan to have a dedicated truck unit within their department; additionally they should have or plan on purchasing scales, if they intend to become involved in weight enforcement of commercial vehicles.

Successful completion of this course will be worth 1 college credit from Monroe Community College.

Tuition for this course is \$128.00 per person plus \$54.50 in student fees. A certificate of residency from out-of-Monroe county residents is required in order to avoid double tuition billing. You will be billed at the completion of the course. It will not be necessary to send a check or voucher prior to class.
