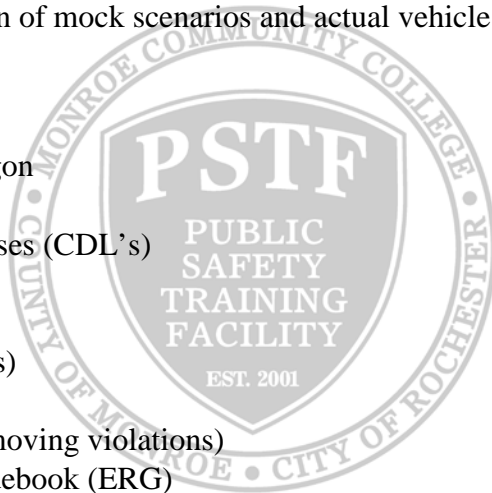
The Public Safety Training Center in partnership with the Greece Police Department will be conducting the **Commercial Vehicle Enforcement (CVE) Course**. This three day course will be held at the Training Center, 1190 Scottsville Road, Rochester, NY, room 109.

This is an awareness level course, designed for law enforcement personnel. Its purpose is to provide the necessary information so that officers can safely and effectively stop Commercial Motor Vehicles (CMV's) in roadside situations.

The course consists of 2 days of classroom and 1 day of field exercise. The classroom portion is lecture/power point and the field day a combination of mock scenarios and actual vehicle stops of CMV's.

The topics covered are:

- CMV terminology and jargon
- Safe stops
- Commercial Drivers Licenses (CDL's)
- Registrations
- Tax permits
- Hours of Service (logbooks)
- Dimensional requirements
- NYS VTL (equipment & moving violations)
- Emergency Response Guidebook (ERG)
- MV-104(S) truck/bus supplement
- Writing UTT's to CMV's
- Counter Terror/Criminal Activity involving CMV's



Successful completion of this course will be worth 1.5 college credits from Monroe Community College.

Tuition for this course is \$192.00 per person plus \$54.50 in student fees. *A certificate of residency from out-of-Monroe county residents is required in order to avoid double tuition billing.* You will be billed at the completion of the course. It will not be necessary to send a check or voucher prior to class.
